## Day before NGT hearing, Rajasthan Congseeks probe into cracks down on waste kilns in Aravallis

In a last-minute damage-control move, Rajasthan authorities dismantled sev eral illegal rubber scrap kilns operating in the Aravalli range — just a day before a cheduled National Green Tribunal (NGT) hearing in

The action follows a suo the NGT based on The Tribune's December 2024 investigative report titled Toxic kilns pollute Aravallis: Wildlife and locals suf-The Tribunal, in its initial proceedings, pulled up Rajasthan and has directed heir respective State Pollution Control Boards and the and Environment Ministries to submit affi-davits within a week.

Acting swiftly ahead of the from Rajasthan raided the Udhanwas village, located along the Haryana border in the Aravalli range, and demolished the makeshift rubber kilns found there. However, sources said the waste mafia got wind of the operation and fled the site with their tools before offiials arrived.

In contrast, no concrete action has been reported so far from Haryana's Tauru block, where similar illegal activities continue to thrive inchecked. The NGT, while initiat-

tial violations of multiple laws: the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Mines and Mineral (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957, and the Biological Diversity Act, 2002. "The news item raises

substantial issues relating to compliance of environmental norms and the implementation of provisions of scheduled enact-ments," the Tribunal observed in its order.

It further said, "The news item on illegal scrap kilns relates to significant environmental challenges faced by the Aravalli region, particularly near the Tauru area

Rajasthan Haryana border due to the proliferation of illegal kilns.

The court highlighted that these portable kilns — num-bering over a dozen — operate without any legal authorisa tion. "They burn vehicle scrap, especially rubber tyres, to produce flattened sheets used as fuel by brick kiln operators," the Tribunal said.

It said, "The combustion process emits toxic fumes, leading to serious health issues for local residents and the displacement of wildlife from their natural habitat. The kilns are severely polluting the soil and water, resulting in cat-

tle deaths and a public health crisis.

The Tribunal also pointed out the lack of accountability. "Despite repeated assur-ances, no stringent action has been taken by the authorities concerned. It is alleged that both Haryana and Rajasthan keep shifting the blame on each other while the issue continues openly

While Rajasthan's late action may appear as compliance, all eyes are now on Haryana, where pressure is mounting for similar enforcement in areas like Tauru, which remain hotspots for these illegal and hazardous operations.

The transfer of Manesar Municipal Corporation (MCM) Commissioner Renu Sogan following a complaint has snowballed into a political storm, with the Congress now demanding a judicial inquiry into the sanitation contract at the centre of the controversy

Sogan was transferred folowing a complaint from Akanksha Enterprises sanitation contractor she had recently accused of mas-sive inefficiency and financial misconduct. According to her internal report, the contractor had allegedly pocketed nearly Rs 50 crore in inflated payments while delivering only a fraction of the agreed services.

The Manesar unit of the

Congress has now made the issue political, releasing photographs of the contractor with several BJP leaders, including former Chief Minis-ter Manohar Lal Khattar. The party alleges that the contrac tor is politically shielded and has been unduly favoured by the ruling government.

Time stood still at Dr Man-galsen Auditorium on Sunday as hundreds gathered to pay their final respects to Lt Vinay Narwal, the young naval officer who died in the Pahalgam ter-ror attack on April 22. The atmosphere was a mix of pride and deep sorrow, as an entire honour a son of the soil.

Vinay's wife, Himanshi, stood in quiet dignity, saluting the man she had married just days earlier on April 16. came from his sister, Srishti, whose tribute moved the gathering to tears.
